

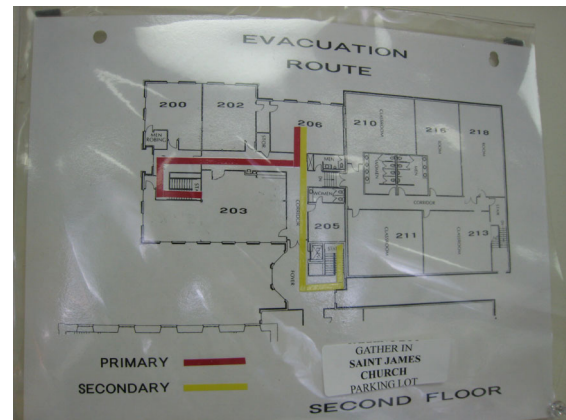

Is Your Class Ready in the Event of a Fire or Emergency?

Each classroom at First Presbyterian Church should have a fire evacuation plan posted near the door. The next time you are in your classroom, take time to review that plan. If the plan is missing from your room, let us know.

If the fire alarm should sound, don't waste time trying to figure out if it is real, a false alarm, or if the fire is near your classroom. Evacuate the classroom immediately and ask questions later!



A Tornado?

We have a weather alert radio at the church. In the event of an impending tornado, we would get the word to all classes to gather in the basement of the church.

Dealing with Medical Emergencies

Our deacons and ushers try to spot doctors and nurses in our worship services so we might utilize their help in emergencies even before emergency personnel are called. However, we cannot always guarantee a doctor or nurse is present.

In preschool and elementary classes, one of the teachers should contact either a superintendent or worker in the Sunday School Supply Room (#109) or go directly to the Reception Desk near the Gathering Space to contact a deacon. We will try to locate a doctor or nurse.

First Aid kits are located in the Sunday School Supply Room, the Curriculum Resource Room, and at the Reception Desk. A cardiac defibrillator is kept at the Reception Desk. Phones are located in the Children's Library and at the Reception Desk if it is necessary to call for outside emergency help.
